- Article 6:** Shall the voters of the Town of Weathersfield approve the expenditure of \$1,261,799 for the support and operation of the Town's General Fund? \$912,461 shall be raised by property taxation, allowing the Select Board to set the appropriate tax rate. **YES** **NO**
- Article 7:** Shall the voters of the Town of Weathersfield approve the expenditure of \$1,224,522 for the support and operation of the Town's Highway Fund? \$947,777 shall be raised by property taxation, allowing the Select Board to set the appropriate tax rate. **YES** **NO**
- Article 8:** Shall the voters of the Town of Weathersfield approve the expenditure of \$261,512 for the support and operation of the Town's Solid Waste Management Facility? These monies shall be raised by non-tax revenues. **YES** **NO**

Article 9: Shall the voters of the Town of Weathersfield approve the expenditure of \$265,070 for the support and operation of a new municipal fire department? \$245,070 shall be raised by property taxation, allowing the Select Board to set the appropriate tax rate. YES NO

Article 10: Shall the voters of the Town of Weathersfield authorize the Select Board to borrow funds not to exceed \$250,000 for a period not to exceed five years for the purpose of resurfacing Center Road? YES NO

Article 11: Shall the voters of the Town of Weathersfield authorize the Select Board to borrow funds not to exceed \$160,000 for a period not to exceed five years for the purpose of purchasing a new grader? YES NO

Article 4: Shall the voters of the Weathersfield School District approve the school board to expend \$5,930,409, which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$16,760.75 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 6.42% higher than the spending for the current year. (By Australian Ballot) YES NO
