


Ascutney Fire District No. 2
Warning - Annual District Meeting
Tuesday, May 7th, 2019


The legal voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2, in Ascutney, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at Martin Memorial Hall, at 5259 Route 5 in Ascutney, in the Town of Weathersfield, Vermont, on Tuesday, the seventh day of May, 2019, at 7:00 o'clock, P.M., to act on the following articles:

- Article 1:** To elect a Moderator for a term of one year.
- Article 2:** To elect a Member of the Prudential Committee for a term of three years.
- Article 3:** To elect a Clerk for the District for a term of one year.
- Article 4:** To elect a Treasurer for the District for a term of one year.
- Article 5:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 authorize the Prudential Committee to borrow money, if necessary, to pay current expenses in anticipation of fees in accordance with the provisions of Title 24, Section 1786, of the Vermont Statutes Annotated?
- Article 6:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 authorize the Prudential Committee to expend such grant monies, gifts, or bequests which may be received by Ascutney Fire District No. 2, in accordance with the terms of said grants, gifts, or bequests?
- Article 7:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 raise and appropriate money to pay indebtedness and other general expenses of the Fire District for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020, and if so, how much?
- Article 8:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 authorize the Prudential Committee to establish a Capital Reserve Fund for the purposes of saving monies for capital infrastructure improvements.
- Article 9:** To transact any other business deemed proper to be brought before the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 Annual Meeting.

Persons residing within the limits of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 who are voters in the Weathersfield Town Meeting shall be voters in the Fire District No. 2 Meeting.
