


**Ascutney Fire District No. 2
Warning - Annual District Meeting
Tuesday, May 21st, 2024**

The legal voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2, in Ascutney, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at Martin Memorial Hall, at 5259 Route 5 in Ascutney, in the Town of Weathersfield, Vermont, on Tuesday, the 21st day in May at 7:00 o'clock, P.M., to act on the following articles:

- Article 1:** To elect a Moderator for a term of one year.
- Article 2:** To elect a Member of the Prudential Committee for a term of three years.
- Article 3:** To elect a Clerk for the District for a term of one year.
- Article 4:** To elect a Treasurer for the District for a term of one year.
- Article 5:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 authorize the Prudential Committee to issue bonds or notes of the Ascutney Fire District #2 in an amount not to exceed One Million Seven hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,750,000), be issued for the purpose of obtaining the Water District's construction funding for the Water Main Replacement Project, such bonds or notes being payable and secured solely by the net revenues of such project, to be matched by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program with up to a 50% subsidy. [To be voted on by Australian Ballot on 5/22/24 from 10am-7pm at Martin Memorial Hall]
- Article 6:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 authorize the Prudential Committee to borrow money, if necessary, through notes or orders to mature within one year, to pay current and future expenses in anticipation of fees in accordance with the provisions of Title 24, Section 1786, of the Vermont Statutes Annotated?
- Article 7:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 authorize the Prudential Committee to expend such grant monies, gifts, or bequests which may be received by Ascutney Fire District No. 2, in accordance with the terms of said grants, gifts, or bequests?
- Article 8:** Shall the voters of the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 authorize the Prudential Committee to raise and appropriate money to pay indebtedness and other general expenses of the Fire District not to exceed \$168,154 for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025?
- Article 9:** To transact any other business deemed proper to be brought before the Ascutney Fire District No. 2 at its Annual Meeting.


